The Japanese as Secondary Language Class (JSL) was established in 1989 to promote understanding and to introduce Japanese customs and culture to the American public through the teaching of Japanese language. The course is designed to provide the basic of elementary Japanese language with emphasis on mature conversation skills.

Waitlists:

If a class is filled, you may request to be placed on a waiting list. You will be notified if space becomes available or an additional class section is scheduled.

Retaking same class:

The current student may retake the same class next semester if the student completes registration by the due date and its class is available.

Registration Fee:

\$50.00 for a one-time registration fee for new students and returning students who has withdrawn from class.

Tuition:

Full payment \$440 or Installment payment: $\$230 \times 2 = \460 (40 classes)

- The tuition must be paid as below to complete your registration.

Checks payable to *Japanese School of Dallas*

- \$440 for 40 classes. The tuition must be paid in full by **Aug 16th, 2025**

** If you wish to make payment by installment, the tuition will be $\$230 \times 2 = \460 .

The first payment (\$230) must be completed by **Aug 16th, 2025**

The second payment (\$230) must be completed by **January 31th, 2026**.

Tuition refund policy

- 100% refund only applicable if we receive notice by email info@jsdallas.org 2 business days prior to the first class (= we will refund 100% only if you send us notice by the end of Aug 14th, 2025)
- Prorated tuition refund – if we receive notice by the end of August 15st, 2025, we will refund except first lesson fee, registration fee, textbook and supply fee. If we receive notice between August 16nd through August 29th, we will refund except the lesson fees which has done already (either you attended or not), registration fee, textbook and supply fee.
- NO REFUND – If the school office receive a cancellation notice after August 30th 2025 and later.
- Tuition is not refundable after third class (August 30th, 2025). Registration Fee, textbook, and supplies are not refundable.

Curriculum

Level 1 Introductory

This course is for those who are taking Japanese classes for the first time.

You will learn to speak and understand basic sentences and be able to make simple conversations. Also, you will learn to read and write HIRAGANA.

The course covers the lessons 1-13 of the textbook “Japanese for Busy People I”.

Although the textbook is the main material in class, we hope you learn not only the language, but also about Japanese culture as well.

1. Basic vocabulary and grammar.
2. Numbering and counting systems.
3. Elementary conjugation of Verbs.
4. Practical lessons in reading and writing “Hiragana” alphabet system.
5. Practice in elementary conversation skills, greetings, useful expressions, identifying objects, basic request and instructions.

Level 2 Beginner

This course is for those who have completed JSL level 1 or its equivalent to Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N5. In level 1, we have learned simple sentences (all three sentence patterns: nominal sentence, adjectival sentence, verbal sentence). Also, the instructor will expect you to read ひらがな because in this course, 漢字 will be introduced.

The course covers the lessons 14-25 of the textbook “Japanese for Busy People I”.

1. Continued use of Japanese alphabet “Hiragana & Katakana” to improve ability and familiarity, and introduction of “Kanji”.
2. Expanded verb conjugation and grammar.
3. Introduction of simple adjectives.
4. Practice in more complex aspects of basic conversation skills, telephoning, and social exchanges, giving and receiving.

Level 3 Upper Beginner

This course is for the students who have completed JSL level 2 or its equivalent to Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N4. The students will learn more advanced communicative skills.

The course covers the lessons 1~7 of the textbook “Japanese for Busy People II”.

1. Continue applying all the writing systems: Hiragana, Katakana and more Kanji.
2. Comparisons: comparative and superlative expressions
3. Using the Adverbial forms of adjective to modify verbs
4. Using the various forms in the verb conjugations to express the situations

Level 4 Intermediate

This course is for the students who have finished JSL level 3 or its equivalent to Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N4. The students will learn more advanced level of communicative skills.

The course covers the lessons 8~15 of the same textbook.

You will learn:

1. The Japanese cultural events as well as the advanced communicative skills.
2. Expressing your opinions, decisions and reasons
3. Expressing your emotions, suggesting about how to solve the problems
4. Talking about the situations using the conditional expressions

Level 5 Upper Intermediate

This course covers “Japanese for Busy People III”

The student will learn structures of Passive, Causative, Honorific, and Plain Imperatives, as well as formal letters and business speeches.

This course is equivalent to Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N3 and can be taken repeatedly until the student is ready for Level-6 Advanced.

Level 6 Advance

This class is for the student who finished level 5 and like to improve conversation, reading and writing skills. Our native Japanese teacher will use Japanese as much as possible during this class. All textbook and materials will be given by the teacher. This course can be taken repeatedly and is equivalent to Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) – N1, N2.

Pre-Registration for current student
